# **Paper preparation**

This year CEUR-WS.org publisher **has changed the requirements to the authors** of the papers to be submitted for the conference. So, we had to make changes in our paper selection criteria.

The CEUR-WS.org requirements concern the authors' DBLP publications (https://ceur-ws.org/HOWTOSUBMIT.html#FAQ-DBLPFOOTPRINT)

In this regard we kindly ask each participant to study actualized <u>paper selection criteria</u> when preparing your submission.

The paper format and style shall be as per <u>CEUR template</u>. An example of paper formatting together with short explanations can be downloaded <u>here</u>.

The minimum size of the paper is 10 pages, except for invited papers (represented by key-note speakers).

All papers shall be submitted in PDF format using direct <u>Easy Chair</u> or via Conference site **http://colins.in.ua/call-for-paper**/.

## Paper publication and indexing

All the papers (except for students' ones) that have been rigorously peer-reviewed and thoroughly evaluated by the Program Committee are submitted for publication to <u>CEUR-WS.org</u>.

All previous papers published in CEUR-WS.org proceedings have been indexed in <u>Scopus</u>, <u>Web of</u> <u>Science</u>, <u>DBLP</u> and <u>Google Scholar</u>.

We are pleased to propose for you kind consideration the <u>proceedings and materials</u> of the previous CoLInS conferences.

### **Conference fee**

The conference attendance for participants from countries other than Ukraine will be 20 Euro. Attending the student's workshop is free of charge both for Ukrainian and non-Ukrainian participants. The payment details will be provided in next information letters provided that the submission will be accepted by the Program Committee.
